BARON

RAMONE

BARON

tress, perhaps even personnes,  
people. You go through, through,  
through. Getting me my brown beans  
of caffeine riches.  
Don't you come back without my  
coffee.

SCENE 2

RAMONE

(MORE)

RAMONE (CONT'D)

Sweet Brunswick tram, that's why I don't want him talk to runners. Anyway, as you can see, he's not getting any better. How are you doing there?

You know, you were probably right about coming in here rather than the streets of Italian Burghers. Fancy lot, think they're some sort of merchant royalty (snorts) and very protective of their coffee. They're still very active in the area and wouldn't appreciate anyone grabbing coffee for someone up in Brunswick...

(Quetly)

Especially THE BARON

(Normal voice)

There are quite a few coffee places nearby. Castros should be right in front of you. And there's also House of Cards to your... left? or maybe to your right. Okay, okay, I'm useless with maps. But that's why we have you! And you're doing great by the way, keep up the good work and we'll find that coffee for the Baron.

### SCENE 3

BARON

You were talking about Castro! What a man he was. Cofeee... all of Cuba coffee plantations. Now, there's a man you can admire! And they worship him even here in Parkville, 15 thousands kilometers away from his island home. Now that is what I call establishin authority. That's what I want runner, do you understand that? I want my coffee.

RAMONE

### SCENE 4

RAMONE

(Sigh)

I see.

Okay, have you been to that Castros place yet, it looks promising.

If you find anything, you have to make sure it's not decaf. The BARON HATES decaf more than he despises the lack of cahfee. There's not much time left. The Baron might fall into the deep sleep any minute now. And where would we be then? Without leader, without suburb, without blessed cahffe.

No, this cannot be our fate. Find the cahfee RUNNER, find the cahfee.

SCENE 5

Sounds of heavy traffic.

RAMONE

I can see why we have you running is definitely a lot quicker than... this.

I mean, look at them all rushing to and from the city, to Royal Parade, to...

Sweet Brunswick! You've found it! Of all places runner? Well what are you waiting for? PICK IT UP! BARON, did you hear? Did you hear what our RUNNER has gained? A bag of Victorian coffee beans. Baron!

(Mumbling quietly)
